

Single Stream Recycling Rules

**Acceptable:**

- Cartons
- Metal cans & clean aluminum foil, pie plates & trays
- #1, #2 and #4\*, #5\*, #7\* plastic food & beverage containers (bottle & non-bottle packaging)
- Phone books
- Corrugated cardboard & paper bags (flattened)
- Newspapers, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)
- Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)
- Cardboard beverage carriers
- File folders & office paper
- Glass bottles & jars
- Junk mail, catalogs & magazines
- Loose metal jar lids & steel bottle caps
- Paper towel rolls
- Paperback books

**Not Acceptable:**

- No scrap metal
- No VHS/VCR tapes
- No plastic bags
- No needles or syringes
- No window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex® dishware
- No stickers or address label sheet waste
- No plastics other than those listed
- No electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)
- No paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- No motor oil or antifreeze containers
- No organic material and food waste
- No waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- No Styrofoam™ or paper to-go containers
- No plastic caps
- No hard cover books

**PLEASE NOTE:**  
 Village residents are asked not to flush certain items down their drains (sinks, toilets, tubs etc.); paper towels, napkins, diapers, baby wipes, other wipes such as Clorox, Windex, etc., ladies' products, cloth or any similar-type materials.  
 These items are commonly found in the Village sewer system and can wreak havoc.  
 Many residents don't realize this, but such materials can cause blockages in the system, which can result in sewer backups in homes, businesses and other facilities.  
 Please try to be considerate and dispose of such materials properly. It will save money and prevent problems in the long run.

### New Water Line Completed

The Village recently completed the new 8" water line on Clinton Street between Union Street and Wallkill Avenue.

Better fire protection, enhanced flow and pressure will all result from this project.

The total cost of the project was \$222,000., and the Village was awarded additional grant monies, which totaled nearly \$150,000.

Plans are already underway to apply for a grant for a new 8" line on the West end of Clinton Street (between Union and Bridge Streets).

If successful with the grant application (H.U.D.), this project will be completed in 2017.

### New Water Filtration for the Village

Plans for the new filter plant at holt well are almost complete. Supt. of Public Works, Bud Nelson, is attempting to procure all the necessary Health Dept. and other permits before we can go to construction.

The entire project is projected to cost \$330,000. This is great news because originally the cost was projected at \$500,000.

Once completed the new plant will filter 75% of the Village water pumped into the water system. This will eliminate the brown water problem (especially in the Water's Edge vicinity).
